9-6-1: DEFINITIONS:

As used in this Chapter, the following words and terms shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this Section:

!DEF! COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENT: Refers to each business or commercial use whether located in its own structure or in a building containing other uses. It shall also include any garage or other building located between the principal structure and any alley abutting the property.

RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE: A structure on any lot used for residential purposes. The term shall also include any garage located between the residence and an alley abutting the property. (Ord. 74, 3-17-1981, eff. 6-1-1981) !DEFEND!

9-6-2: ADDRESSES REQUIRED:

A. Designation: All residential structures and all commercial establishments shall have affixed to them the proper street addresses as designated by the City.

B. Size; Location: The numbers constituting the street address shall be in arabic, shall be at least four inches (4") in height and shall be located so as to be clearly visible at all times from the street and, in situations requiring posting on garages, clearly visible from the alley. 9-6-3: PENALTY:

The owner of any property required by this Chapter to have its address posted who fails to do so shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor. Failure to comply shall constitute a separate offense for each day the violation continues. (Ord. 74, 3-17-1981, eff. 6-1-1981)
