## GENERAL PENALTY

1-4-1: GENERAL PENALTY<sup>1</sup>:

Any person violating any provision of any ordinance of this City or any rule or regulation adopted or issued in pursuance thereof, or any provision of any code adopted herein by reference, shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not more than seven hundred dollars (\$700.00) or by imprisonment for a term not to exceed ninety (90) days or both. (Ord. 55, 1-13-1970; 1996 Code)

1-4-2: ISSUANCE OF ORDINANCE VIOLATION CITATIONS:

A. Purpose: It is the intent of the City Council to allow designated nonpeace officers to issue citations for violations of those ordinances which the nonpeace officers are authorized to enforce. The City Council finds that the swift and efficient enforcement of the City's ordinances will be promoted by allowing those nonpeace officers most familiar with the ordinances to have full authority to enforce them.

B. Grant Of Authority: Nonpeace officers shall have the authority to issue citations in the areas of their responsibility as follows:

1. Building Inspector Or Building Official: The Building Inspector or Building Official shall have the authority to issue citations to enforce the provisions of Title 4, Chapter 2 and Title 9, Chapters 1, 3, 4, 5 and 8 of this Code.

2. Code Enforcement Officer:

a. Disposal Of Garbage And Refuse: The Code Enforcement Officer shall have the authority to issue citations to enforce the provisions of Title 2, Chapter 4 and Title 4, Chapter 2 of this Code. (Ord. 86, 11-24-1992; 1996 Code)

b. Nuisances: The Code Enforcement Officer or parttime maintenance person shall have the authority to issue citations to enforce Title 4, Chapter 1 of this Code, and in his absence, grant the Maintenance Supervisor authority to issue citations to enforce Title 4, Chapter 1 of this Code. (Res. 6-13-1989; 1996 Code)

c. Zoning: The Zoning Administrator or parttime person shall have the authority to enforce Title 10 of this Code. (Res. 7-11-1989; 1996 Code)

3. Zoning Administrator: The Zoning Administrator shall have the authority to issue citations to enforce the provisions of Title 10 of this Code.

4. Fire Inspector Or Fire Marshal: The Fire Inspector Or Fire Marshal shall have the authority to issue citations to enforce the provisions of Title 4, Chapter 2 and Title 9, Chapter 2 of this Code.

5. Plumbing Inspector: The Plumbing Inspector shall have the authority to issue citations to enforce the provisions of subsection 9-1-1A16 of this Code.

6. Tree Inspector: The Tree Inspector shall have the authority to issue citations to enforce the provisions of Title 4, Chapter 3 of this Code. (Ord. 86, 11-24-1992; 1996 Code)

7. Staff:

a. Animal Control: The Code Enforcement Officer shall have the authority to issue citations to enforce Title 5, Chapter 3 of this Code. (Res. 6-13-1989; 1996 Code)

b. Emergency Parking After Snowfall: The Code Enforcement Officer shall have the authority to issue citations to enforce the provisions of subsection 6-1-6B of this Code. (Ord. 86, 11-24-1992; 1996 Code)

c. Sidewalks, Curbs And Gutters: The Code Enforcement Officer shall have the authority to issue citations to enforce Title 7, Chapter 3 of this Code. (Res. 7-11-1989; 1996 Code)

8. Other Persons: Such person as may be designated by the Mayor or City Council shall have the authority to issue citations to enforce the provisions of Title 4, Chapter 1 and Title 5, Chapter 3 of this Code. (Ord. 86, 11-24-1992)
